STEP 1

You just learned that you will experience temporary hair loss as a side effect to your treatment.

First visit to your Capilia centre to:

Evaluate your current hair: density, colour, length, texture, style.

With a consultant, select and try on prosthesis in your price range.

Discuss the alternatives to wearing a hair prosthesis: hat, turban, scarf or other.

Establish if you want to get a transitional haircut to better prepare yourself for hair loss.

Obtain answers to all your questions and concerns.



STEP 2

2 to 3 weeks from your first treatment, your hair will begin to shed.

Second visit to your Capilia centre to:

Get your transitional haircut.

Fit, cut and style your new prosthesis.

Receive your prosthesis care products, the scalp care products to soothe your scalp, your wig holder, a night cap and a brush.

Learn how to take care of your hair prosthesis at home.

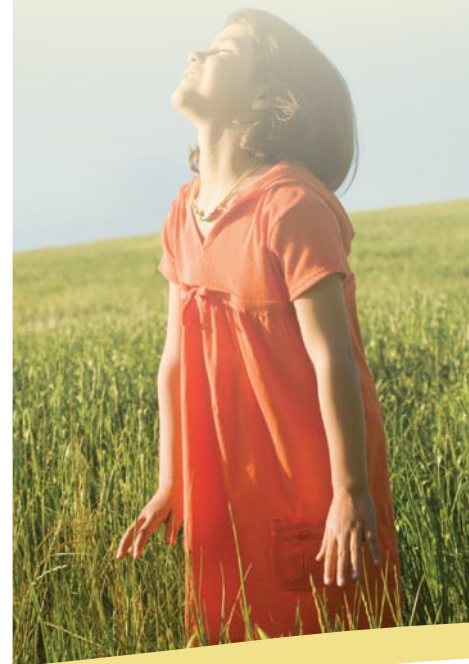
Learn how to take care and protect your irritated and sensitive scalp at home.



STEP 3

During your medical treatments, you may wish to visit your Capilia centre to make adjustments to your prosthesis or to have it reconditioned.

In order to soothe your sensitized scalp while undergoing your treatments, we recommend that you use the Laboratoire Nature products that are suited to your needs.



STEP 4

Your treatments are completed. You will begin to see a new hair growth approximately 2 months after the last treatment. Hair usually grows at an average rate of 6mm (1/4") per month.

60 days after the end of your treatments, plan three (3) visits to your Capilia centre to:

Receive a scalp treatment that will soothe your irritated scalp and encourage an optimal hair regrowth.

A few months after regrowth has started, visit your Capilia centre to:

Shape and style your new hair growth.

Learn how to maintain and protect your scalp in order to encourage a healthy regrowth.
